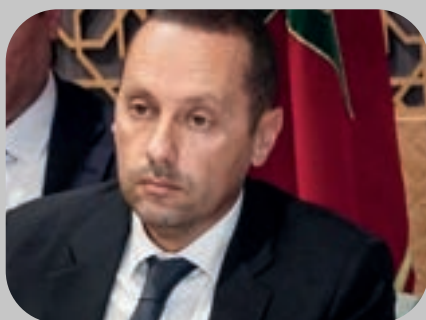



FRAMEWORK NOTE
